

January 9, 1986

The Board of Directors of the Womelsdorff Community Library met this evening in the Library at 7:00 P.M. Present were, Mrs Rebecca Rohrbach, Pres. Mrs Janet Gehlke, Mrs Cheryl Young, Mrs Pat Detroit, Mrs Anne Coffey, Mrs Pat Storr Librarian and Mrs Betty Kippley.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as corrected. The treasurer reported a balance of 447.93. Mention was made that the Word Book Encyclopedias were paid in advance in the amount of 433.00 and should be received very shortly. Mrs Rohrbach reminded the members that the Bethany Childrens Home will accept our present copy of the year book when the new set arrives.

Correspondence included a card from Mrs Mc Kee ^{together} with a \$50.00 donation. A letter from Essex & Barr thanking us for our business. We buy our Treasurer bond from them.

Mrs Storr, Librarian, reported that 443 books and magazines were checked out during December. She requested permission to order magazine files and was told that she may make any purchase for which the money has been allotted in the budget. This is one of the items.

The members unanimously agreed to join the Friends of the Library in Reading this at a cost of \$25.00.

There was discussion on the handling of overdue books and how to deal with offenders. There is nothing to do except contact them and keep copies until they return them. Those who are not returning books will not be allowed to remove any other books and will be so instructed.

Pat Storr asked the members opinion on having the new year books taken on. They decided that this could be done and handled as the use of the other year books had been.

Under new business Janet Gehlke reported on the Summer Reading Program subject for this year tentatively set for a Health & Safety Program with speakers on the various phases of Health & Safety to speak during the week. Janet and Pat Storr and Pat Detroit will set up this program and report at a later date.

National Library Week will be celebrated the 2nd week in April and plans will be made for some special events.

A silent auction for sometime in May was discussed and suggestions made to have it outside. A date will be set at a later date.

Cheryl Young submitted her resignation as of Feb 1, 1986 due to her new employment. This was accepted with regrets on motion made by Ann Coffey seconded by Rebecca Rohrbach.

Jodan Allen's name was submitted ^{as a replacement}. She has been contacted and is willing to serve. The Borough Council will be advised of this recommendation and will probably act on it at their next meeting.

A motion was made by Betty Gepply, seconded by Pat Stone that with the resignation of Cheryl Young, ~~that~~ her duties as Treasurer be turned over to Pat Tetruck. Motion was approved.
