

November 13, 1986

The monthly meeting of the Board of Directors of the Women's Community Library was held this evening in the library at 7:00 p.m. Present were Mrs Rebecca Rehnbach, Pres, Mrs Anne Cobley, Mrs Pat Stover, Mrs Pat Hetrick, Mrs Jo Ann Allen & Mrs Betty Keppley.

Mrs Rehnbach presided at the business meeting. The minutes of the previous meeting were read & corrected showing the balance in the treasury to read 929.33 instead of 542.51 as recorded in the minutes. The treasurer reported a balance of 608.07.

Mrs Hetrick presented the budget for 1987 that will be \$7250.00 which is less than that for 1986 which was 7,470.00.

A type writer chair will be ordered thru with funds from 1986 budget. The Bus trip in Dec will net \$600.00 for our Library.

Starting Jan 1, 1987 all Library financial business will be computerized. Shirley Berkhaus, Borough Secretary, has volunteered to handle these transactions & we can check on everything through her.

Mrs Cobley reported sending thank you letters to Cleda Westal, PTO - Women of Today & Naomi Drubeller for money & books received.

Following discussion Pat Hetrick was requested to check with Council through Borough Secretary, the possibility of changing the lock between the Council Room & Library. It was also suggested that a space for parking be made available for the volunteer working at night - 7 to 9. It was here noted that all volunteers have been notified of the change of Library hours starting Jan 1, 1987 namely - Mon & Tues 3-5 - 7-9
Tues - Thurs. Sat - 10 to 12.

The gift wrapping class will be held Monday, Dec 15th, 1986 in the library at 7 P.M. Mrs Naomi Francke Instruker. As there was no further business - meeting adjourned.
