The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. The treasurer reported a balance of \$2156.49. The corresponding secretary reported on correspondence sent to Edith Fetterman, president of the Friends of the Library, thanking them for the \$475 check received. Mrs. Fetterman praised our Library for the good work being done for the Community.

Chet Hagen, Editor of the Book Ends published by the friends of the Library was also informed that the Library will purchase a new typewriter - this is something not noted in the budget. (Mrs. Rohrback, moved, seconded by Laker Hartman to purchase a typewriter).
