The monthly meeting of the Board of Directors of the Womelsdorf Community Library was held this evening at 7 P. M. in the Library.

The following members were present: Rebecca Rohrbach, pres. Ann Coffey, Janet Kehle, Lois Hoak, Lakerie Hartman, Pat Hetrick & Betty Kessler.

The minutes of the March 9th meeting were read & corrected to read that Mrs Rohrbach & Mrs Shach, <sup>representing the Cultural Heritage Committee</sup> prepared a book compiled with many interesting articles concerning the Bi-Centennial. This book was presented to the Library at tonight's meeting by Mrs Rohrbach. Along with two parts of the Constitution.

Pat Hetrick reported that the new hours & new volunteers are working well. The three books by Charles Adams will be bound for the Library.

May 14th trip to Hunterdon Hills Playhouse is being handled by Corinne Keller. Cost \$5.00 per person.

The Summer Reading Program was discussed & Rebecca Rohrbach explained the use of coal in making a garden. This was decided upon as a good project for the Summer Program.

They can be made in a small jar or fish bowl. Each child will make his own "magic" garden.

The visit by the German families on June 3rd to June 5th was discussed and if necessary library room could be used for informal party being planned when they arrive. No definite place for this celebration has been decided on.

Pat Hettrick presented a project for next Christmas and possibly at Easter as well. Frances Merriman could be asked to wear her Santa Claus suit & Easter Bunny outfit so that children could pose with him & have their pictures taken at a cost of \$1.00. This will be pursued for a money making project next winter & spring probably on a Saturday here in the library. Lore Haak will fix the display case for May. As there was no further business the meeting was adjourned.
