We received from the "FRIENDS of the READING PUBLIC LIBRARY" a donation of \$475.00 to purchase an item or items not included in our budget. Purchasing shelves was discussed and, if more money is needed to use the money from the Mary Moore Memorial Fund.

appropriate choice and appreciated it very much.

Gerry Reed suggested to have the Tulp. Historical Society books bound together in two hard cover volumes, also, she would check into getting the missing volumes.

Gerry also read a letter on the Governor's Library Conference to be held in Washington D.C. in 1991.

The board voted on changing Library hours on Tuesdays from 1 to 3 to 3 to 5. effected April 1 1990, because of the low amount of material circulated on this day.

Gerry Reed made the motion and Lori Haak second it. Larue Hartman will make posters, announcing this change.

"Happy Birthday" Book markers have been purchased and stamped with "Womelsdorf Community Library" and March 3, 1990. These are to be given out at our birthday party on March 3rd.
