Summer Reading Program will be held July 10th to August 14th. (This year Janet Tchuli has spoken to a Mrs. Luckenbill who expressed an interest in doing crafts for this program).

The Birthday party on March 3rd was attended by approximately 50 people & was considered a successful party.

Since the cost of mailing the annual letter is such an expense it was decided to deliver the letters by hand asking volunteers to assist. out of town will have to be sent through the mail.
