The minutes of the secretary's report were read and approved.

The treasurer reported a balance of \$6764.36 as of Sept. 30th.

The corresponding secretary wrote thank you letters to members who made donations, and to Connie Lorah and Kathy Staby for leading the summer reading program.

Under the Librarian's report Gerry asked if we wanted to continue with the Junior Library Guild. Through the Guild we receive four Juvenile books each month. The board approved by a motion made by Anne Coffey, seconded by D. Baker. Also we received a letter asking for a donation from the H.F.W and J.C.'s concerning the War Memorial Fund. during the winter months. Ruth Beffinger can only work monday mornings. A suggestion of having male volunteers was discussed but no one came to mind. Bonnie Werner was charged both a fine and the cost of the book. She was very upset and wanted to resign her membership. Larve made a motion to refund the fine money (\$5.00) and Lori second the motion. Also to have Gerry write her an apology letter.
