Under the Librarian's report Gerry asked if we wanted to continue with the Junior Library Guild. Through the Guild we receive four Juvenile books each month. Larue made a motion to refund the fine money (\$5.00) and Doris second the motion. Also have Gerry write her an apology letter.

Under Old Business Pat Helrick will continue to be in charge of the Donckers fashion show the motion was made by Doris second by Anne. The Library will sponsor a bus trip to Wintertur and Longwood Gardens on December 9 1990 at the cost of \$41. Cunnie Keller will be in charge.

Under New Business the Librarian's salary will be raised to \$40 a week and the Assistant Librarian's to \$20 a week retroactive to October 1. on a motion made by Ann and second by Doris.
