The monthly meeting of the Womelsdorf Community Library was held this evening at 7 PM in the Library. Present were Louise Hartness, who presided, Lois Haal, Doris Baker, Gerry Reed, Ann Coffey & Betty Keppler.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as corrected. Treasurer's report showed a balance of \$6204.41 balance as of Oct 31st. The fashion show proceeds amounted to \$330.67.

Corresponding secretary reported on the thank you letters written since the last meeting.

Under old business the Book Sales which are held on election days were discussed and it was decided that since they have not been too successful they will be discontinued. Since the Library board was approached for a donation for the Memorial Fund Louise made a motion, seconded by Ann Coffey to donate the \$20.00 from the cake sale. Motion approved.

Also under old business the matter of book shelves discussed previously was again presented. Following discussion it was decided to have Lois & Gerry get shelves and to spend \$1,000.00 for this project.

Under new business it was decided to try some new magazines. Some of those mentioned were Country Living & Early American Life. Gerry was told to order Early American Life first to see how it is received. The purchasing of some up to date books on health was also suggested.

The National Library week will this year be celebrated from April 14-20th. The national theme "Read-Succeed" will be the topic. Plans for our library will be made at a later date.

The Corresponding secretary was instructed to write a letter to the Borough Council requesting some type of roof covering to be placed over the entrance door to the Library to protect those entering the Library on rainy days.

As there was no further business the meeting was adjourned.
