The monthly meeting of the Womelsdorf Community Library was held this evening at 7:00 P.M. in the Library. Present were, Lillian Hartman, Pres. who presided, Loni Haak, Janet Tchuli, Dixie Baker, Anne Coffey, Gerry Reed and Betty Keppley.

The secretary report was read and approved.

The treasurer reported a balance of \$5,259.76 which includes a check for \$600 received from the Friends of the Library.

Corresponding secretary reported on letters written to those who donated both time & money to the Library since the last meeting.

Gerry Reed, Librarian, reviewed several pieces of mail received from various magazine companies making offers for their subscriptions. No action was taken. A \$25.00 check was received from Peter Anthony after Gerry wrote to the company telling them that we did not find it suitable for members of our Library. Mr Anthony requested that the book "Simply" be returned to him directly and explained that he did not find it unsuitable.

A book "Breaking Point" was also received from the Dinkley family - parents of the young man who shot Pres. Reagan and others. They are giving all proceeds they make to the further study of mental illness. (We already had a copy of this book when it was first sold).

The Summer Reading Program will use as its theme "Read-Succeed". As last year, we will again observe National Library Week. During which a special program will be held on Thursday, April 18th. It will be entitled "Remembering Fashions". Loni Haak will be in charge of making the arrangements. Slides and fashions will be shown.

Posters will be made and placed throughout the Community as well as the annual letter to be written and distributed to all members. This will again state that National Library Week will be Amnesty Week for all those who have overdue books. They will be asked to return them at that
