National Library Week will be held April 5-11, 1992 - Suggested theme "Discover Your Library". Pre-school Story Hour started Oct 8th to continue through Nov 19th. Time 9:30-10:30 - Brenda Acheak and 2 assistants to be in charge.

Under old business - national Children's Book Week was reviewed. It was decided to have children make up book marks. The 9 of Nov. will be deadline for submitting marks. There will be 4 classes - Pre-school, Kindergarten to 3rd, Fourth - fifth & sixth grades and Jr High & up. \$5.00 gift certificates will be given and Patsy Swope, Jr will be asked to judge.

Under new business the budget was presented and discussed. Motion was made by Doris Baker, seconded by Lorie Hoak to accept the proposed budget.

It was also decided to have as many Board members as possible attend the Oct Council meeting to explain our proposed budget.

Several methods of acquiring funds for the Library were suggested. Free shelf - donating a book and donations in general.

As there was no further business the meeting was adjourned.
