The monthly meeting of the Library Board of the Women of Today Community Library was held this evening in the Library at 7 P.M. The following attended: Pres. Labeu Hartman, Janet Tchali, Doris Baker, Gerry Reed & Betty Kippely.

The minutes were read and an addition to the minutes was made concerning the decision to post a sign stating that children under five must be accompanied by an adult and cannot be left unattended. This decision was made at the November meeting.

Treasurer reported a balance of \$5,742.98. This report was accepted subject to audit.

Mrs Bennethum, pres. of the Women of Today presented the Library with a \$500.00 donation. This will be used for children's reference books. The Librarian will check out National Geographic

Magazine to be donated. They are the complete sets from 1960 to 1970. A thank you will be sent to Leon Engle for the National Geographic

Deposit Collection will no longer be carried out through the Reading District. This will effect large print books. These will have to be purchased from now on.

Gerry Reed, Librarian, asked the opinion of members whether to continue sending certified letters to those who have not returned overdue books, after repeated contacts by phone and card. A motion by Doris Baker, seconded by Betty Kippely it was moved to not send any certified mail.

The matter of misfiled books was discussed and the Librarian will leave a note for volunteers concerning this.

Dec. 20th is the deadline to register for the workshop to be held Jan 13th at the Ag Center. Cost is 12.00 if interested.

Gerry Reed a list of books that have been considered for banning from Library shelves during Banned Book Week. No action is felt to be necessary in our Library.

Pre-School Story hour on Dec 3rd made Christmas Cards and will take them to Independent Towne between Christmas and New Year. They will sing Carols for the guests.

Pre school will start again in January.

A call was received from John Davis office to see whether we had completed our application for a grant we are eligible for. This has been taken care of by Gerry.

Lorrie Hartman reported attending the Borough Council workshop concerning their suggestion that we spend a possible grant through the Council for large print books. This need is not as great as that for <sup>any</sup> outside changes that could be made. Such as handicap accessible facilities and an overhang of some kind for the existing entrance.
