Treasurer reported balance of \$19,475.13 as of Dec. 31st (pending bills not yet received for 1998).

A letter of resignation was submitted by Kathryn Turner who will no longer serve as a Trustee as she and family are moving out of the area. Sharon Grits resigned as Treasurer, will, however, remain on the Board. Lynn Herbine, an accountant, has been chosen to be the treasurer and since he is a member of the Borough Council to be a non-voting member of the Board.

Sondra Westbrook reported an increase in the circulation of book from 1997-1998-1999. She also reported that the bar coding is started and must be completed by March. All trustees and volunteers along with interested members of the Library will be working on this project. A suggestion was made to have the Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts assist with this project under supervision of a Trustee. The form received from the Green Thumb Program will also be completed and submitted, possibly giving us some help in getting this job completed. Sondra will be able to give the Library more hours starting Jan. 15th, (she will eventually be working 28 hours a week). Computers are here and ready to be used by March. Community Service - youths projects are being carried out in the Library - straightening out books etc.
