Monthly meeting of the Trustees of the Womalsdorf Community Library met at 7:15 P.M. Present: Doris Baker, Fran Schaefer, Sharon Math, Sally Gibson, Cathy Polcrack, Betty Keppley, Sandra Westbrook, Librarian and Allan Schaefer, Council Representative. Minutes were approved from previous meeting. Treasurer's report was accepted subject to audit. Wynne Wehring who had previously accepted the office of treasurer notified the Trustees that due to previous commitments he would not be able to free their positions.

The two events held since the last meeting were very well attended and brought new people into the Library.

A new letter will be prepared for the Boy Scouts to deliver door to door so that the upcoming events will be known to all members in the community. A night of Poetry, a once a month story hour on a Sat. morning, a Sat. morning with a pet rabbit, a Teddy Bear Tea and the Summer Reading Program starting in June are some of the programs to be planned.

The last two items for the Library have arrived, the computer table and a copier table. They have been set up and put into use.

It was decided to offer our Library for a Fall meeting of the System Librarians.

Bar coding continues, and to present nearly a third of the books have been coded. The Boy Scouts have been helping the Volunteers and will continue to do so until the job is completed.

The Library Funding Petition is the most important project at the moment. All Trustees will get as many petitions as possible until March 5th for the System's office and to the State Representatives until March 12th.

Requests for adult movies such as Titanic have been made and the Librarian will check whether other libraries are purchasing

them for their patrons to use. At the present time we do have a few, mostly GP rated.

There will be one program scheduled for Tues, March 16th at 7 P.M. This will be in the form of a workshop on making Photo Books and preservation of same. The speaker will be the Pres. of the Bernville Board of Trustees.

As there was no further business the meeting adjourned at 9:20 P.M.
