Monthly meeting of the Womelsdorf Community Board of Directors was held this evening at 7:15 P.M. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and corrected. The program for Sunna Reading will be held on Thursday from 10 to 11 instead of Tuesday. The end date will be August 28th.

Treasurer reported a balance on April 30th of \$15,153.17.

Doris reported on her April 23rd & 24th Trustee's meetings which she attended. Very interesting subjects "Do Your Duty", "Financial Response", "Friends and the Board - It's a Marriage", "Pulling the Team Together". Sondra, reported on her sessions she attended on "Rare Books".
