Monthly meeting of the Trustees of the Womelsdorf Community Library met at 7 P.M. Present - Doris Baker, Sharon Guth, Joan Schaezle, Cathy Palczak, Betty Kuppel Librarian, Sondra Westbrook and Allen Schaezle, County Representative.

Minutes of previous meeting approved.

Treasurer report was accepted subject to Audit. (# 21852).

Business: Book Sale profit - \$199.25. Boro will be contacted for projected figures on salaries. Motion was made by Sharon Guth & Joan Schaezle to have Library pay one half of the cost of repairing air conditioning when received. The Library will pay \$195.01 for the work completed on the computer system. As of this time the plans are for Library to go on line June 10th. Classes have been held for those interested. By January 2000 the system requires all Librarians to be open some times on a Saturday and Sunday.

All Librarians in the system will receive a yearly visit from the Board of Directors from the main Berks County System office.

The First grade students of Conrad Weiss West in the guise of the Librarian and all were introduced to the use of the Library as well as a short story.

The Book Prop must be repaired or replaced.

Swimming pool managers requested reading material for the use at pool. All old condensed Reader's Digests donated to Lib will be given to them as well as magazines donated.

The Librarian will be on vacation from July 1 to 10. Assistant Librarian and Volunteers will be at the Library. The Library will be closed Monday, July 5th, 1999.

The Personnel Policy was reviewed and changes were made as suggested.

The Summer Reading Programs are all well planned but as yet there is no program for the last day. Several contacts were suggested.
