Treasurer's report was approved subject to audit. Balance Sept 30th \$25,680.63

Mr. Balistreri, president of the Boro Council explained to the Board how they should handle their incorporation into a non-profit business for J.R.S. We will hire an attorney.

We also gave us the name of Sandy Nunemacher a possible Audit Consultant for the coming year. Audits must be carried out every year if accounts exceed \$25,000. Every other year if less than that amount. October 1st is the deadline for audits. Kathy Polcack and Joan Schaezle will attend the workshop for Library Trustees on Oct 16th.

Tickets are now available and being sold for the Oct 24th breakfast sponsored by the Rotary. Proceeds to be divided between the Wernerville, Robeson & Womelsdorf Libraries.

Allen Schaezle reported on the purchase of a water cooler. The placement of same was discussed and on motion by Joan Schaezle and Sally Gibson, Schaezle was told to utilize its appropriate place in the west end of the Library.

A letter of resignation from Chester Hanel was accepted with regret. By-Laws Review - No changes made.

Personnel Policy and Collective Development Policy were reviewed and changes made accordingly.
