The monthly meeting of the Womelidoy Community Library was held this evening at 7:10 P.M. Present - Luvia Baker, Joan Schaezle, Sharon Heth, Betty Kapprey and Sandra Westbrook, Librarian. Minutes of the previous meeting read and approved. Treasurer's report filed subject to audit.

President Baker reported that following the business of the October meeting a sub-committee was formed and drafted the long range goals as follows:

Under Goal 2 we will strive to

1. Improve marketing of the Library services and resources:

B Place notices in local newspapers, news letters

2. Organize "Friends of the Library Group".

Under Goal 3 we will

Conduct a survey of Library users to determine the real needs of the community and better meet those needs.

Under Goal 4 we will:

2. Expand our video collection

3. Offer a wider variety of programs for children.

Two new Goals are as follows:

Goal no. 5 -

Organize an adult book discussion group

Goal 6

Purchase an additional public access system.

The above goals were unanimously approved at this meeting. The Library System Plan was completed for the System office. Under business it was decided to pay the Borough \$9700 to cover the Librarian's share of salary payments for the remainder of the year.

The December tea will be held as planned and stories will be read by Cathy Polerack and Sally Gibson.

The names of Harriet Grimes, Suzanne Seyler, Lalue Hartman, Louise Miller and Roseann Meredith have been submitted to the Board Council for approval to be Board Directors starting Jan 1, 2000.
