Systems: the 2008 prospective budget was presented. Bookends newsletter will now be sent to all Trustees. Applications for the 2007 Library Systems Awards are now available.

Capital Campaign: we will give Ceramic Lady one more month to create acceptable turtle tiles before searching for a new vendor. We should create a new capital campaign letter by November to be sent to library users.

Librarian's Report: Circulation for August 2007 totaled 6534 as compared to 5631 in August 2006. Collection Expenditures for August 2007 totaled \$1645.71. The director requested coverage on Tuesday, October 23, so she can attend the Board Meeting. V. Cook made the motion to allow Lee to cover those hours. The motion was seconded by B. Hedbavny and the motion passed. We'll look into our budget for permanent Tuesday double coverage.

Old Business: the Grand Opening went well with over 300 attendees.

New Business: We welcome our newest Board member, Lorelei Lewis to her first meeting. We need to find a vestibule rug and an outdoor rug for library addition.
