County Recycling Events

There are two special county-wide recycling events this month which are free for county residents. The first is a Paper Shredding event, held October 14 from 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m., at a new site—the Berks County Ag Center (1238 Welfare Rd., Leesport). The second is a Household Hazardous Waste event, held October 21 from 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m., also at the Berks County Ag Center. (Type of items accepted: turpentine, oil based paints, varnishes, stains, weed killers, asphalt and driveway sealants, herbicides, antifreeze, transmission & motor oils, oven & drain cleaners, fluorescent bulbs, button batteries, polishes, lithium & NiCad batteries. Some items are not accepted; the Solid Waste Authority's website provides more details.)

The county sponsors on-going electronics and tire recycling at their Bern Township location at 1316 Hilltop Rd., Leesport, every Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. There is a fee to recycle tires. Many electronics are accepted. Visit the Berks County Solid Waste Authority's website for all the details, or call 610-478-6362.

White ash trees continue to be removed from Umbenhauer Park because of the presence of the Emerald Ash borer. A significant number of ash trees may be removed later this year or early next year by a contractor; this could necessitate a brief closing of the park for safety reasons. Your cooperation will be appreciated at that time. Until then, individual trees may be removed on a periodic basis, so the borough asks for your continued cooperation when using the park to avoid any limbs. brush, or logs that are on the ground.
